Top new ringtone songs english

Using the ability to edit iTunes songs by David Weedmark, you can convert any song into a personal ringtone for iPhone. All you have to do is create a copy of your favorite track and then pinch it a little to make it a ringtone that you can use iPhone. Ringtones should be 30 seconds or less, so you need to choose which part of the song you want to use. Start iTunes. If prompted, sign in using the apple ID and password your iPhone uses. Drag a music file to the iTunes Music library, or press Ctrl-O to import it. Find the song in your Music library or playlist. Right-click the file name and select Info List. In the window that opens, click the Options tab. Click the check boxes next to The Song's Start Time and Pause Time, and then change the times so that the length of the song is 30 seconds or less. If you want to start the song in a minute, change start time to 1:00 and Stop Time to 1:30. Click the whole. Right-click the song again. This time, select Create AAC Version to create a copy of your song in AAC format. If you don't see this option, you need to change your iTunes preferences (see next step). A recurring 30-second version of the song appears in the Music library below the original. If you don't have the option to create an AAC version of a song, press Ctrl-B to reveal the iTunes Menu bar. Then choose Preferences from the Edit menu and the Transfer Settings button on the General tab. Click the Import using menu and select AAC Encoder. Click All twice to close preferences windows. Right-click your original song file, which still shows the exact time full-time, and then re-select Info. Highlight and delete Start Time and Stop Time, and then click Full. This returns your original song file to its normal length. Open Windows Control Panel, select View and Personalization, and then click Folder Options. Click the View tab, and then clear the check box next to Hide extensions for known file types. To make a ringtone file, you need to see the file extension of the song. In iTunes, right-click the 30-second AAC version of your song and select Angle in Windows Explorer. In Windows Explorer, right-click the file and select Rename. .mp3 extension and replace it with the .m4r file extension used for ringtones. Press Enter. Click the menu button in the upper left corner of iTunes, which must select Music' and Tones. Your new ringtone appears on this page and shows that you have correctly changed the file extension. Connect your iPhone to computer using usb cable. Select your iPhone when it appears at the top right of the iTunes window. Click the Tones tab, and then click the Sync Tones button. After synchronization is complete, apply, and then click Click , close iTunes, and then turn off the USB cable. Start Settings from the home screen of iPhone. Scroll down and tap Sounds. Scroll down again and tap Ringtone. You can do the following select a custom ringtone from the list of available options. Ringtone is the sound your phone sounds when there's an incoming call. Usually, this means a good selection of ringtone sites on the Internet that are compatible with dozens of control and phone models. Some sites charge for the use of their ringtones, for song royalty cover, among other things, and some sites provide free tones. Many old songs (such as classic tracks) have been around long enough for copyrights to expire -- they've been in the public property, so it's free for everyone to use. Once you find a ringtone like, you just have to get into your phone's memory. Depending on your specific phone model, there are several ways to do this. There are three main way to add a new ringtone: Advertising Install a ringtone program over a data cable, from a computer to a phone. Send the program from the broadcast to the phone. Use the key key to type the program directly on the phone. Phones can only use a specific method, but phones have many multiple options. Use to find out what your phone is capable of Check. If you Installing ringtones with the right phone, software and computer configuration, a data connection or infrared interface can be a simple option, but initially it requires some work and spending to set everything up. A more popular method is to send new ringtones to your phone via airwaves. This approach originated with Nokia, but other manufacturers have since added this capability to their phones. The basic idea is to send a custom text message to the phone that includes the program for ringtone -- on most phones, this is done using text messaging service or Advanced Messaging Service technology. Nokia initially developed the Text Message Service to send text text messages between phones. Next, Nokia and Intel created a special protocol for sending functional, non-text information via smart messaging, SMS. Basically, the most common method to transfer ringtones through Airwaves is coded to allow a smart SMS message equipped phone to recognize as a graphic, ringtone, etc. a ringtone to visit the website, get a tone, enter your phone number and allow site administrators to send messages directly to your phone. Alternatively, you can use an SMS gateway site to send a specific message to the phone yourself. This means finding the code for the ringtone you want, finding it appropriately (e.g. Nokia binary format) and copying it as a smart message. Mobile phones with a melody composer allow you to type ringtones directly. The easiest way to use this feature is to find the appropriate keystroke array for a melody on the Web. Of course, for the ringtone to work, the array must be in the correct format. Fortunately, you can find tons of arrays online for most phone models. Already, some phones boast the ability to ringtone too loudly, meaning the phone can play more than one note at a time, allowing for richer, harmonious melodies. Some new phones allow you to record songs and voice messages for ringtones yourself. Many of these models also let you assign different ringtones to different incoming numbers, so you know who's calling you without even looking at your phone.
